AGENDA:

This being the first meeting of the committee as formed by Mayor Dan Carpenter it will serve as the organizational meeting for our group. My goal is to leave here with volunteers who will follow up on individual conclusions reached after discussion of the following:

1. The experience of other communities. EG: "Tree Toga", the City of Watervliet, others.
2. Inventory of existing trees, dangerous trees and sites where new plantings would be welcomed. Possibilities for cross referencing sites with tax rolls.
3. Review of the different types of street trees and their efficacy for individual locations
4. Sources for trees. The National Grid program, the State nursery, local tree services and garden shops
5. Review of possible funding sources. The Village budget, potential subsidies from other sources, possible grants
6. Research into potential contractual agreements with property owners for cost sharing of new plantings and/or removals
7. List of the names of people who should be asked to join the committee or to make presentations to the committee. EG: Tree Toga folks
8. Other ideas or suggestions

It is hoped that this meeting will conclude in a timely way and that participants will agree to reconvene within 30 days.
