Bid opening for RFP for SAM sidewalk project

The bids were opened by the board at 6:22 pm. At the counsel of our attorney, the board rejected all bids due the fact that NYSDOT has demanded that the village must obtain stamped engineer plans before they will issue a permit for this project. The board will issue a revised RFP with the specs and plans included.

Presentation of the Tentative Budget to the Clerk

The board presented the clerk with the tentative budget. All documents required by law were present at the meeting. Mayor Carpenter tasked Treasurer Heyman with posting the tentative budget on the website.

Regular Workshop

Tyler Yocum presented a request to the board to install picnic tables in Fort Hardy Park. He provided the board with detailed plans for the tables. Trustee LeBaron asked if at least one of the tables could be made to accommodate a wheelchair. Tyler stated that this could be accomplished. Trustee Baker suggested that Tyler should contact Curtis Lumber to see if they would be interested in donating the lumber and possibly Palette Stone for the gravel. The board thanked Tyler enthusiastically for his presentation and stated that they would certainly be approving this project at the next village meeting.

Charles Sherman was present to give his waste water treatment plant report. Sherman stated that he was still working on the application for the SPDES permit. Fifty-nine Church Street, Trish Orlogio, has a collapsed sewer line. She asked about grants that would assist her with the cost of replacing the line. Treasurer Heyman stated that Dawn Riley has received a home improvement grant through the Town of Saratoga for the replacement of a water line and that possibly Ms. Orlogio could try that route. The board discussed the location of the lines in that area and the options that she would have for connection.

The building erosion issue was discussed. Heyman stated that when she contacted NYSDOT, she was told that the state will be doing some major work on the intersection of Green and Spring, and that it was possible that the work would be something that would accomplish the storm water mitigation for us. She has reached out to a contact that will have more information on this subject and will keep the board updated on the matter.

There was an application for parade gathering permit for cardboard boat race. The board noted that it was at the same time as one of the coin drops, but Trustee Baker stated that he did not

think that they would conflict, as the contestants would all be down at the water front well before the start of the coin drop.

Schuyler Hose Coin Drop Application Trustee Colvin asked that we ensure that we do not have a coin drop every weekend and that there should be at least 2 weeks between them (every other weekend at the most) as he feels it is annoying to the residents to have too many coin drops.

Animal Action requested permission for their annual coin drop. The board had no issue with this event providing that the safety protocols were followed and that they had the appropriate insurance that was required.

Director Jenny Winters submitted a request for funds for the Schuylerville Youth Center. The board asked that she provide a list of expends to justify the \$7,000.00 request and that there be a contract for the services provided for the youth for the village as is required for any requests for funds.

Trustee LeBaron made the motion to adjourn the meeting, Trustee Drew seconded the motion, all in favor, meeting adjourned.
